



Justice?

Drinking water supplies contaminated with toxic chemicals.

Rivers oozing with oil spills and uncontrolled pollution.

That was America 35 years ago. That's why Congress passed laws like the Clean Water Act and the Safe Drinking Water Act to protect our health and environment.

But Supreme Court nominee Samuel Alito has:

- prevented citizens from enforcing the Clean Water Act against a polluter who admitted 150 violations of the law — using legal reasoning later rejected by the Supreme Court;
- overturned an emergency EPA order requiring a polluter to clean up toxic pollution threatening the drinking water for 180,000 people; and
- taken an extremely narrow view of the constitutional authority that underlies most federal environmental laws.

Judge Alito's rulings show that he doesn't believe Congress has the authority to pass key provisions of the Clean Water Act and other environmental laws. With the Supreme Court scheduled to rule on landmark Clean Water Act cases this year, *that's not the kind of Justice America needs.*
