6	I'm Judge Williams. Let me ask counsel to please identify
7	themselves for the record. For the Plaintiff?
8	MR. GORDON: Good morning, Your Honor. Steven
9	Gordon on behalf of Plaintiff, and with me is Christine Walz.
10	THE COURT: Good morning to both of you.
11	And for the Government?
12	MR. TERRELL: Good morning, Your Honor. Stephen
13	Terrell, and with me is Barbara Marvin, M A R V I N, also
14	with the Department of Justice. And also on the line is
15	Gladys Cojocari, C O J O C A R I, with the Department of the
16	Interior, Office of the Solicitor.
17	THE COURT: Well, thank you all for participating.
18	The reason for the conference is logistics in the scheduling

- 19 of your trial. The Court must postpone the November trial.
- 20 I apologize. As you know, we're down now six judges, and we
- 21 have to give priority, by statute, to our emergency cases,
- 22 and we have a lot of them. It's the end of the fiscal year.
- 23 So, you can't have the November two weeks. I talked -- I
